




Europe-Mobile Team 2015

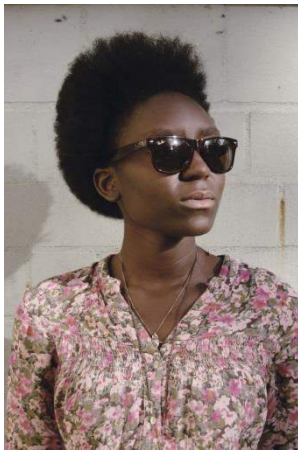
Miglena Koleva (Bulgaria)
